

International Students Admissions

Hendersonville Christian Academy has been approved by the United States Department of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) to admit international students. Our admissions staff is experienced in the process of issuing the I-20 and other forms necessary for students to study in the United States.

Hendersonville Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply to Hendersonville Christian Academy, please follow the following steps.

1. Complete the Application for Enrollment form.
2. Submit \$ application fee.
3. Submit all available high school transcripts in English and original language.
4. Submit an official copy of the TOEFL iBT score report.
Please note that the minimum TOEFL score to be considered for admission is 70.
5. Complete a personal interview.

KEY THINGS TO KNOW

1. HCA accepts students for August enrollment only. Our priority application deadline for August 2016 enrollment is April 15, 2016.
2. International students are required to interview with an admission representative. We will consider a cyber broadcast interview once we receive all application materials.
3. After the interview is complete, we will notify international applicants of our admission decisions within two weeks. When international students are accepted to HCA, we will issue an I-20 and mail a hard copy of admission letter.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT PROCESURES

1. Registration and curriculum fee must be paid before a student begins classes. Once paid, the registration fee is not refundable for any reason. The curriculum fee is not refundable after July 1, 2016.
2. Annual tuition must be paid in full by July 1, 2016 or you must arrange to have payments automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account over the course of ten months.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The HCA Tuition Assistance Plan (TAP) is available to all families based upon demonstrated financial need regardless of race, color, gender, or national and ethnic origin. Requests for tuition assistance must be completed by June 1, each year.

The following policies apply to TAP.

1. Financial assistance is available for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade.
2. Assistance is for tuition only. Registration, curriculum, late stay, and other fees must be paid in full.

3. Funds are dispersed equitably based on need. Those seeking financial assistance must disclose financial information to the school's designee. HCA has partnered with FACTS Management to determine financial need.
4. Assistance beyond need verified by FACTS is at the discretion of HCA and its agents and will preclude students from participating in TSSAA sanctioned sports.
